


- Launched Prevention and Eduction program in 2005
- Serves Central Oregon



# KIDS Center's Prevention Start- 2005

- 1 FTE
- DC-CASTF assessment in 2004
- Goal to train 5% of population-Tipping Point (7,600 adults)
- Train 3,000 adults by 2009
- Conducted 1st SOC training August 2005

- Targeted trainings
  - Our Staff
  - Task Force Partners
  - YSO
    - Parks and Recreation
    - CA Agencies (CASA, MtStar)
    - Family Access Network
  - Faith
  - Health Department
- Planned a marketing campaign
  - Billboards/Radio/TV/Print
- Trained 13 facilitators
- Trained over 900 people in SOC

- Trained 950 adults
- Launched Media Campaign





- Trained over 1000 people
- Media Campaign Completed
- Hired our Prevention Specialist (1.5 FTE Total)
- Housing Market Crashed

- Trained over 3,500 people total from 2005-2009
- Trained over 830 people
- Volunteer facilitators participation started to dwindle

# 5,000 Adults Trained Celebration!!!















- ONLY 537 people trained
- End of the Market Crash
  - Finances were tight
  - Volunteers were moving away=less facilitators
- Kim was hired and two previous prevention people left.

- 590 people trained
- Cumulative to date 6,500 adults trained
- Assessment of strengths and weaknesses
  - Hired an FTE- Crook County (LIVES THERE)

- Hired a Prevention Specialist for Jefferson County
- Facilitators are at an all time low
- Trained 498 adults in SOC
- SOC 2.0 released

- Campaign running for 9 YEARS!
- Added a member to our board from the school district
- Trained 498 adults in SOC
- Who were we missing?

- Erin's Law Passed
- Created a SOC media campaign
- Hired a bilingual Prevention
   Specialist (Prevention ONLY)
- Protect Our Children- The Ford Family Foundation- 3 year grant
- Hit tipping point in 2 of our three counties
- Trained over 1059 adults in SOC

One in Ten Children will be sexually abused by the age of 18.








- REACHED TIPPING POINT in all three counties!
- 10 year mark for the campaign
  - Now for the other 95%
- Trained over 1147 adults in SOC
- Marketing campaign still going


- Much smaller marketing campaign
- Only trained 397 this year
- Trained over 10,000 to date
